How We Do It Now

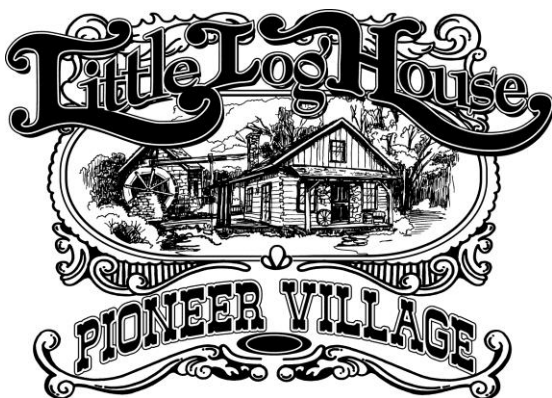
Mary Lawrence
