



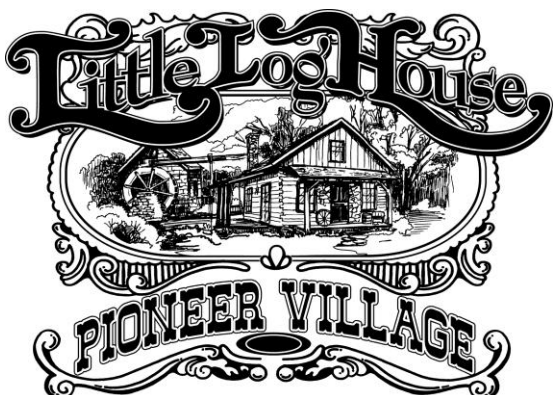
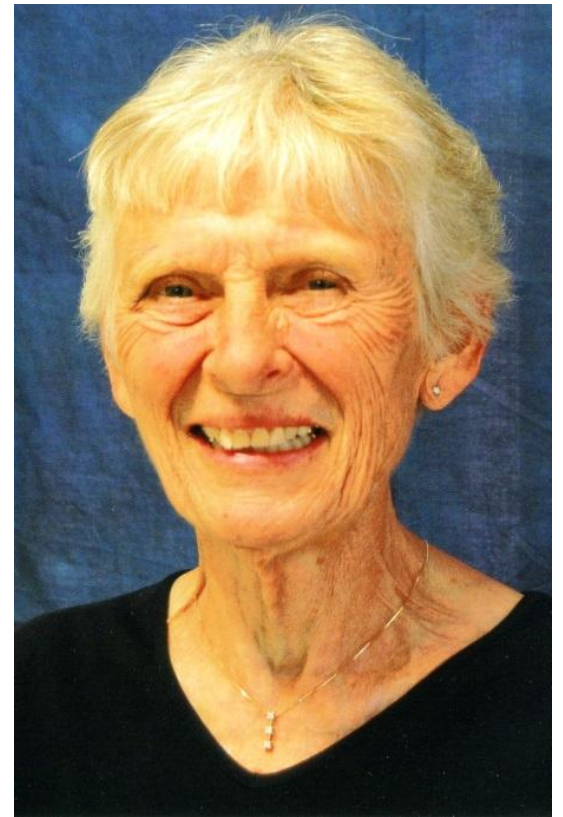
40th Anniversary Speakers

Orphy Beattie

Path International Certified Driving and Riding Instructor

Orphy Beattie is one of the founding members of the St. Croix Horse and Carriage Society and has been active in carriage driving for decades. She grew up on a dairy farm in Minnesota and started driving draft horses at an early age. She became a Registered Nurse and after college rode light horses which progressed to driving light horses. Orphy has participated in Pleasure Driving Shows and Combined Driving Events. She has also presented several clinics with emphasis on safe driving.

Professionally she worked at Gillette Children's Hospital with children with special needs. She then worked at Ramsey Hospital (now Regions Hospital) in child psychiatry. She is currently working part time in home care.

In 1998 Orphy combined her love of horses with her love of children starting as a driving instructor for Special Needs People for Courage Center and then for River Valley Riders. After 15 years, she retired and received the Sis Gould Driving Recognition Award in November 2012 presented by Path International.
